



## From High School Senior to CSN Student Admission and Registration Process "Student Success is our Number One Priority"

The College of Southern Nevada requires that all graduating seniors complete the following steps in order to register for classes.

1. **Admissions:** Apply for admission with a CSN Recruiter, or online at [www.csn.edu/future](http://www.csn.edu/future) and select apply for admissions online.
2. **Financial Aid:** Apply for Financial Aid using the FREE Application for Federal Student Aid at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) beginning January 1st. It is important that you apply by CSN's priority deadline of March 1st. Applying early will allow you to obtain the maximum amount for both federal and college based aid. After you submit your FAFSA, follow the steps provided on CSN's Student Financial Services home page available at [www.csn.edu/financialaid](http://www.csn.edu/financialaid).
3. **Testing:** Submit official SAT and or ACT scores or complete a **FREE** placement test for English, Mathematics and Reading at one of CSN's Testing Centers. For locations and hours please visit [www.csn.edu/testing](http://www.csn.edu/testing) and select the Testing Sites link. Bring your CSN student identification number and a valid photo ID. Allow yourself two to three hours to complete these tests. [Intended for DEGREE, CERTIFICATE, OR TRANSFER students only]

**Review for Placement Testing:** If you are not submitting official SAT/ACT scores, we strongly recommend reviewing prior to taking placement exams. Reviewing could boost your score considerably thus preventing you from taking developmental level courses not covered by financial aid, in addition to saving you time, money and keeping you on track to timely graduation and/or transfer. 4. **Counseling:** All new students seeking a degree, certificate or transfer path must first meet with a CSN academic counselor/advisor to select appropriate coursework according to the student's major. 5. **Orientation:** All new students must take part in a "Student Success Orientation". Attend an orientation to meet new students, learn about college services and to better navigate the CSN system. To register for an orientation session please visit [www.csn.edu/orientation](http://www.csn.edu/orientation). [Intended for DEGREE, CERTIFICATE, OR TRANSFER students only]

**EXCEPTION:** New students interested in learning more about Limited-Entry Health Sciences Programs must also attend a separate Health Programs Orientation through the Division of Health Sciences. 6. **Registration:** You must be an admitted student to register for classes (see steps 1 through 5). To familiarize yourself with the MyCSN registration system, visit [www.csn.edu/aboutmycsn](http://www.csn.edu/aboutmycsn).
7. **Student ID Card:** Make sure to obtain your CSN Student ID Card. Visit our Cashier's Office in one of our three main campuses and show a current semester schedule along with a current photo ID. Cards are issued at the Office of Student Life and Leadership Development – Student Government.
8. **Tuition & Fees:** Pay Tuition and Fees by the due date either in person or by visiting [www.csn.edu/tuitionandfees](http://www.csn.edu/tuitionandfees) and select Apply/Register. Tuition and Fees are subject to change, so please visit [www.csn.edu/admissions](http://www.csn.edu/admissions) for updated payment information.
